The directory is a guide for artists who are interested in locating places to display and sell their work — from traditional crafts to contemporary artwork — and for anyone seeking arts events in Ohio.

Organizers and promoters who want to list their arts festivals or competitions should fill out the questionnaire at <http://www.oac.ohio.gov/sestivalDirectoryQuestionnaire.pdf>.

The deadline for entry in the 2013 festival direc-

tory is Sept. 28. The directory contains detailed information about arts and crafts festivals and competitions, including dates, activities, number of spaces available for artists to display their work, fees and contact information. It is organized by date and location and includes alphabetical indexes of festivals by name, city, region and sponsor.

The directory is published by the Ohio Arts Council and distributed in partnership with the Ohio Arts and Crafts Guild, Ohio Designer Craftsmen, Ohio Division of Travel and Tourism, Ohio Department of Transportation, Chambers of Commerce, Convention and Visitors Bureaus and AAA offices around the state.
